**CO-ED from September 2021!**

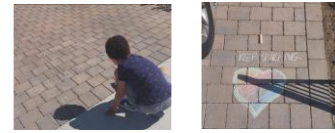

We look forward to these exciting times and to sharing them with all of our wonderful families and the entire community of Dublin 8.

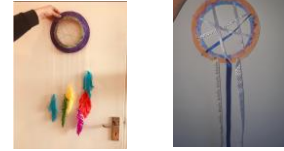
